The award-winning 'Safe & Warm' grants are available to owner-occupiers who are either in receipt of a qualifying benefit (see list overleaf), disabled, or over the age of 70.

Grants are available for:

- Gas central heating (if your home doesn't already have it)
- Heating controls
- New boilers
- Loft, cavity wall and hot water tank insulation
- Draught proofing
- Door and window locks
- Door viewers and chains
- Smoke alarms
